Covid-19 Case Data for City of Missouri City

(as of December 18, 2020)

- *Total Confirmed Cases to date – 2,835*
- *Current active cases – 560*
- *Deaths to date – 69 (as of Dec. 11, 2020)*



City Emergency Operations Center (EOC)

- *Activated since March 12, 2020.*
- *Currently at a Level 2 (1 is the highest level)*
- *Operating virtually with weekly meetings*
 - *Facilitated by the City's Emergency Manager*
 - *Includes all department directors, Command Staff and City Management*
 - *County and City Situational awareness and data updates*
 - *Review Incident Action Plan for the week*
 - *PPE status and needs*
 - *Service Level Impacts*



Fire/EMS Medical Director and City Health Authority

- *Physician contractor on staff*
 - *Dr. Joe Anzaldua*
- *Services*
 - *Liaison to the County*
 - *EMS Treatment Protocols*
 - *Advises on policy*
 - *On-call and advises on Human Resources Covid-19 employee protocol*
 - *Will Facilitate vaccination plan for Missouri City First Responders*



Next Phase – Vaccination Plan

- *December 11, 2020 Fire and Police staff participated in Medical Panel Webex on vaccination.*
- *Fort Bend County Health and Human Services will coordinate through Dr. Anzaldua*
- *Fort Bend County phased approach to vaccination*
 1. *Hospital Staff (beginning soon)*
 2. *Long-term care staff working with vulnerable residents*
 3. *EMS providers engaged in 911 pre-hospital care and transport (end of January)*
 4. *Home Health Care workers*
 5. *Residents of long-term care facilities*
